

O-1B Approval

If beneficiary is in the U.S. in valid nonimmigrant status, he or she can begin working for employer upon approval of the O-1B petition

If beneficiary is outside the U.S., our team will guide and assist with the visa application at U.S. Consular post abroad

\*Extraordinary ability for the arts is defined as Distinction, which means a high level of achievement in the field of arts evidenced by a degree of skill and recognition substantially above that ordinarily encountered to the extent that a person described as prominent is renowned, leading, or well known in the field of arts.
