



### What is the Cap?

Annual limit of H-1B visas:

o 65,000 Regular H-1Bs + 20,000 U.S. Master's or higher H-1Bs



- If more H-1B registrations are received than visas available = Lottery
- Lottery = Computer-Generated (Random Selection), first all registrants, then
  U.S. Master's or higher registrants not selected initially
- Specialty Occupation
  - o Minimum Requirement: Bachelor's Degree in a specialized field

#### **General Timeline**

- January Employers identify H-1B Cap candidates (registrants) and inform Immigration Counsel
- **February** Immigration Counsel + Employer + H-1B registrant work on Pre-Registration Groundwork (see more below)
- March Registration & Lottery selection is from March 1st -March 18th
- April Filing of H-1Bs for selected registrations begins
- June Filing of H-1Bs for selected registration ends
- **July** Second lottery (potential)
- Oct 1st Effective start date of approved H-1B



### Pre-Registration Groundwork

### **Employers:**

- Jan-Feb Identify H-1B registrants and designate authorized signatory
- Feb-Mar Set up myUSCIS account and become familiar with myUSCIS account
- Mar Approve Attorney representation & H-1B registrations ("Hand Shake")
- Work with Immigration Counsel to:
  - Establish eligibility of H-1B cap registrants, positions, wages, location
  - Have a plan for those on OPT, STEM OPT, CPT, or any other immigration status
  - Have a plan for Premium Processing usage

# • Provide education

- Provide educational credentials, immigration and other documents.
- Passport expirations renew, if needed
- Credential evaluation, if needed
- Consider and plan for the inability to travel abroad during this process



### **Registration & Lottery Selection**

- Employers and their Attorneys create & update myUSCIS accounts for H-1B cap registrations
  - Attorney prepares registration and G-28 as authorized representative
  - "Hand Shake" USCIS issues passcode for Attorney to give to Employer who uses passcode in their account to approve Attorney and H-1B registration(s)
  - Attorney receives approval of representation & can continue to work for Employer
- Preparation of H-1B registrants' qualifications, specialized positions, wages & more
- Immigration counsel submits and monitors registrations
- Registration closes, USCIS conducts lottery & updates my USCIS account with "selected"


