## **Travel Checklist for Visa Holders**

Travel continues to bring added scrutiny for visa holders. Use this quick checklist to help ensure smooth re-entry, avoid delays, and stay compliant while traveling abroad.

✓ Pre-Travel Checklist	
	Passport valid 6+ months beyond intended U.S. stay
	Valid visa stamp (Canadian citizens are visa exempt but must still prove status)
	Do NOT travel if a petition is pending
	Check consular appointment availability early if stamping needed
	Carry copies of key documents (as applicable)
	o Form I-797 (approval notice)
	○ Valid I-20 and EAD
	<ul> <li>Pay statements</li> </ul>
	Notify UP and manager early about travel plans
	Notify HR and manager early about travel plans
	Build in flexibility for delays
✓ At t	the Port of Entry
	Prepare for device searches (such as phones/laptops)
	Answer questions clearly and confidently
	Have paper copies of key documents
✓ Aft	er Reentry
	Check your online CBP I-94 record
	Confirm status, category and expiration date
	Report any errors to CBP promptly
	Travel safely, plan early!
